



### CoC Membership Notice

Membership in the Houston/Harris County Continuum of Care (CoC) allows for participation in the selection of the Steering Committee and the ability to participate in setting policies for the CoC. Additionally, organizations that are members of the CoC may receive additional points in renewal and new project funding competitions.

Membership in the CoC is open to all organizations and individuals seeking to prevent and end homelessness in Houston, Harris County, and Fort Bend County. Members of the CoC are able to vote for Steering Committee members and on key policy issues.

To become members, each organization seeking membership will be required to designate two “authorized representatives” in addition to the CEO/ED (who are always authorized to represent the organization). An authorized representative must have sufficient authority to speak and vote on policy issues on behalf of the organization. Each year, the member organizations must designate their authorized representatives to the CoC lead agency.

Organizational members of the CoC must meet minimum participation thresholds to maintain their membership. These thresholds are: participation by authorized representatives in a minimum of 75 percent of quarterly Provider Input Forums. Failure to meet participation thresholds will result in forfeiture of CoC membership and a loss of voting privileges.
