**COALITION FOR THE HOMELESS HOSTS
ANNUAL WORLD HOMELESS DAY LUNCHEON OCTOBER 12**

**Ric Campo – Camden Chairman & CEO and Houston Super Bowl Host Committee
Chairman – to Give Keynote Address**

HOUSTON, TX – The Coalition for the Homeless will host its annual World Homeless Day Luncheon on Oct. 12 at 11:30 a.m. at the Hilton Americas-Houston. For more than 33 years, the Coalition has served those who serve homeless individuals by leading in the development, advocacy, and coordination of community strategies to prevent and end homelessness. This year's event is themed "The End Zone is in Sight" as a nod to both the success that the region has seen in efforts to solve homelessness and the work that still lies ahead.

Ric Campo will be welcomed as the keynote speaker. He is an advocate for homeless individuals and has been a large supporter of the region's efforts in solving homelessness, including serving on the Mayor's Leadership Team on homelessness. Campo has been the Chairman of the Board and Chief Executive Officer of Camden since 1993. As the Chairman and CEO of one of the nation's largest multifamily Real Estate Investment Trusts, Mr. Campo holds strategic roles within the real estate industry. He has served on the Board of Directors of numerous organizations in Houston including Houston First Corporation, Central Houston, Inc., and the Greater Houston Partnership. Additionally, he is currently serving as the Chairman of the Houston Super Bowl Host Committee.

Since 2012, the Coalition has worked tirelessly alongside more than 100 partner organizations toward the goal of solving homelessness through a collaborative known locally as The Way Home. The Way Home has been extremely successful, noting a 57% reduction in

homelessness in Houston, Pasadena, Harris County and Fort Bend County since 2011; and announcing the effective end of veteran homelessness in June 2015.

During the event, the Coalition for the Homeless will award ten World Homeless Day Awards to deserving individuals, agencies and organizations. The Coalition is currently accepting nominations. Award categories include: Achiever of the Year, recognizing formerly homeless individuals who have successfully transitioned out of homelessness; Bridge Builder, individuals or organizations outside of the homeless response system who have made a valuable effort to help individuals stay housed; Business/Corporation of the Year, a corporation that supports the Coalition and its partners' efforts to end homelessness; Housing Partner of the Year, a property manager, landlord, etc. who has worked to decrease barriers and help homeless individuals move into affordable housing; Media Champion, an individual or organization that puts a spotlight on the issue of homelessness or provides coverage on homeless issues and solutions; Peg Dudar Individual Advocate, an outstanding advocate for the homeless population; Sally Shipman Service Provider Staff, a nonprofit employee whose work is dedicated to the homeless community; Services Partner of the Year, an agency that provides crucial services to help individuals attain and maintain housing; Spirit of Collaboration, the collective effort of various organizations that have worked together towards ending homelessness. Nominations will be accepted through 11:59 p.m. on Aug. 31. Visit <http://bit.ly/WHDA2016> to nominate a deserving individual, organization and/or agency.

Through this annual event, the Coalition for the Homeless raises funds to support their programs: research (including the local Homeless Management Information System (HMIS) database); project management (Homeless Court, The Way Home lead agency); system capacity building (training and education); and public education (advocacy).
