Veteran Housing Progress:

January 2012 - October 2018
Effective end of Veteran homelessness announced June 2015.

6,694 Veterans Housed

45 Veterans housed in October 2018.

Ending Chronic Homelessness Progress:

January 2012 - October 2018

5,103 Individuals Experiencing Chronic Homelessness Housed

43 individuals experiencing chronic homelessness housed in October 2018.

Rapid Re-housing Progress:

January 2015 - October 2018

3,525 Individuals Housed

3,011 Individuals Exited to permanent housing

Youth/Young Adult Housing Progress:

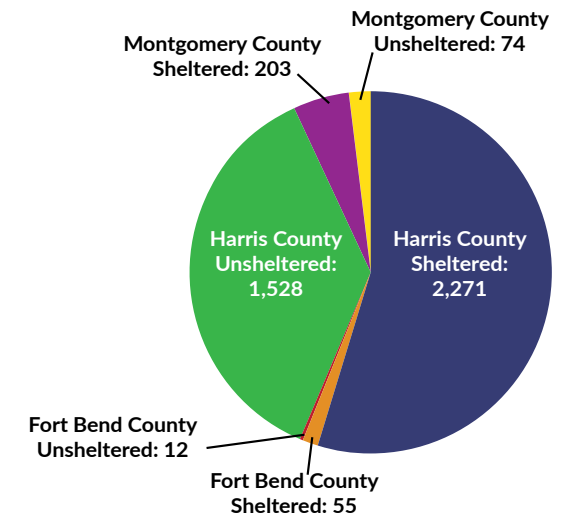

Total: 4,143



We have seen a 51% decrease in overall homelessness since 2011.

We have seen a 63% reduction in unsheltered homelessness since 2011.

18% of unsheltered individuals surveyed during the 2018 Count named Hurricane Harvey as their homeless trigger.
