Veteran Housing Progress:

January 2012 - January 2019
Effective end of Veteran homelessness announced June 2015.

6,817 Veterans Housed

33 Veterans housed in January 2019.

Ending Chronic Homelessness Progress:

January 2012 - January 2019

5,216 Individuals Experiencing Chronic Homelessness Housed

35 individuals experiencing chronic homelessness housed in January 2019.

Rapid Re-housing Progress:

January 2015 - January 2019

4,084 Individuals Housed

3,671 Individuals Exited to permanent housing

Youth/Young Adult Housing Progress:

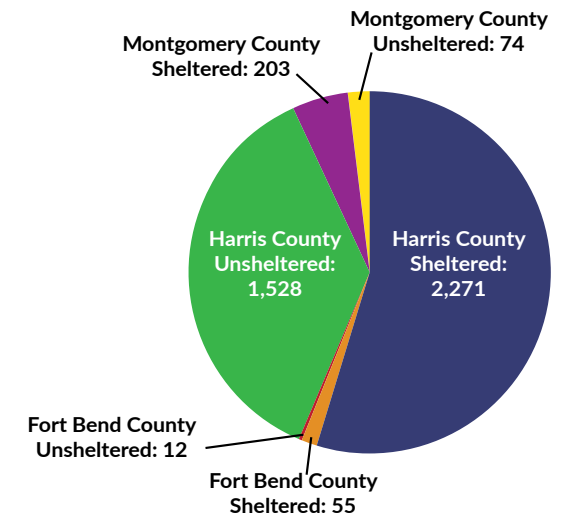

We have seen a 51% decrease in overall homelessness since 2011.

We have seen a 63% reduction in unsheltered homelessness since 2011.

18% of unsheltered individuals surveyed during the 2018 Count named Hurricane Harvey as their homeless trigger.
